Also present during all or part of the meeting were Deputy City Clerk, Alisha Davidson. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Motion was made by Browning to approve the Agenda, with the addition of Dollar General Cigarette Renewal. Seconded by Halbrook and carried 4-0.

Motion made by Halbrook, seconded by Burkett to approve Resolution 2022-09 – Resolution Authorizing Fund Transfers. Roll Call: Halbrook-AYE; Browning-AYE; Gobush -AYE; Burkett-AYE. Motion carried. Diephuis absent.

Browning made the motion to approve the claims to date, seconded by Burkett and motion carried 4-0.

Halbrook presented on B&B Propane smart pay program. B & B will be sending out a new contract for a locked in price of \$1.919. Motion was made by Browning to approve the new contract and seconded by Gobush. On vote, motion carried 4-0.

Halbrook presented on disposal of tires for Farmington residents. Discussion was tabled until next monthly meeting.

Request was reviewed from Villages of Van Buren for advertising of Scenic Drive Festival. Halbrook made a motion to donate \$100.00, seconded by Browning. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion was made by Browning to approve Hel-Mart renewal of Beer permit. Seconded by Burkett. Motion carried 4-0.

Motion was made by Halbrook to approve renewal of Dollar General cigarette permit. Seconded by Burkett. Motion carried 4-0.

Notices of violations were discussed. Properties will be reviewed and evaluated at the next monthly council meeting.

After discussion of wages for the next fiscal year Halbrook made a motion to increase full time Park Manager Salary by 5%. Motion was seconded by Browning. Motion Carried 4-0.

Motion was made by Halbrook to increase Deputy City Clerk wages by \$1.00 per hour. Motion was seconded by Browning. Motion carried 4-0.
